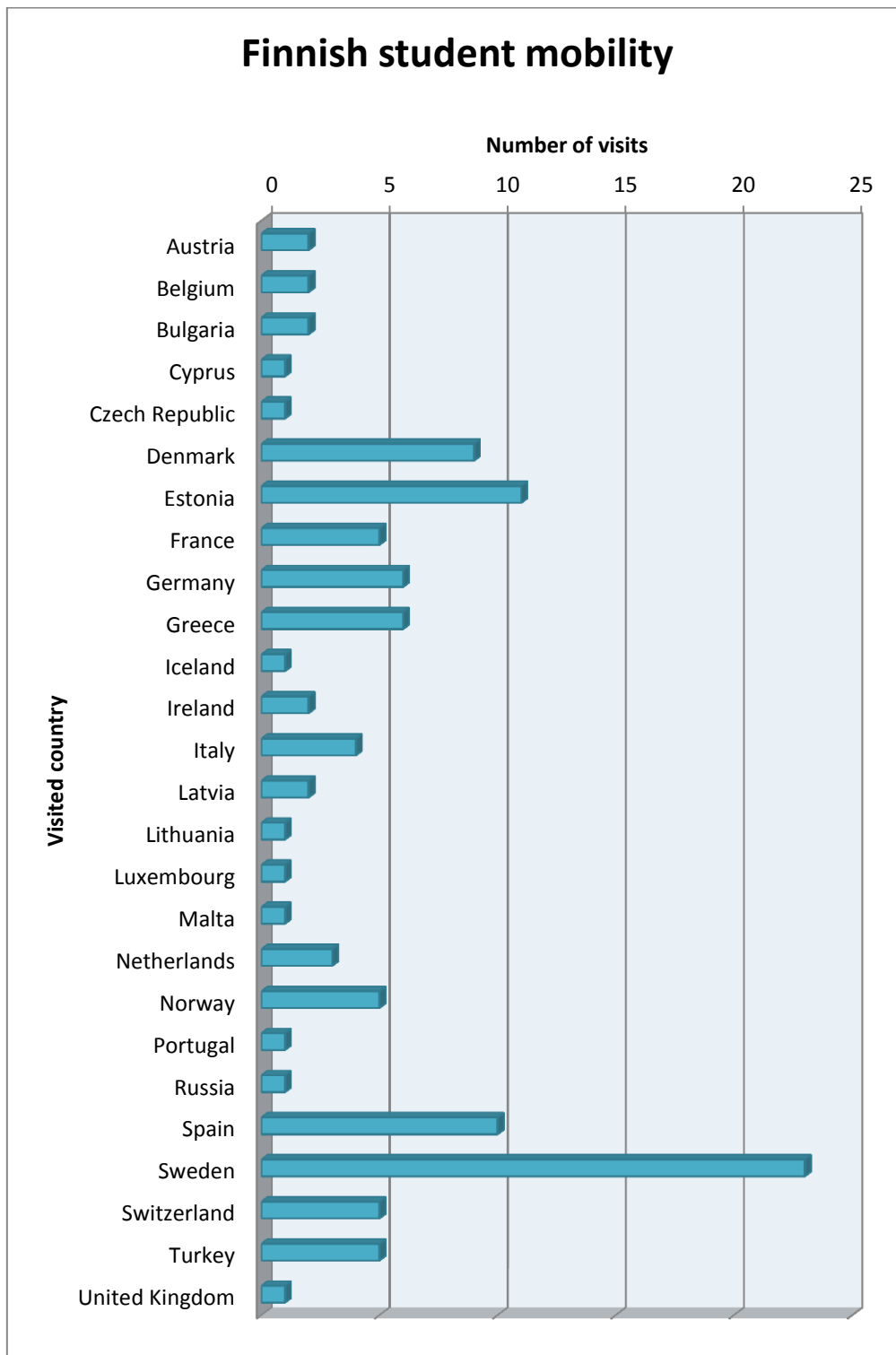




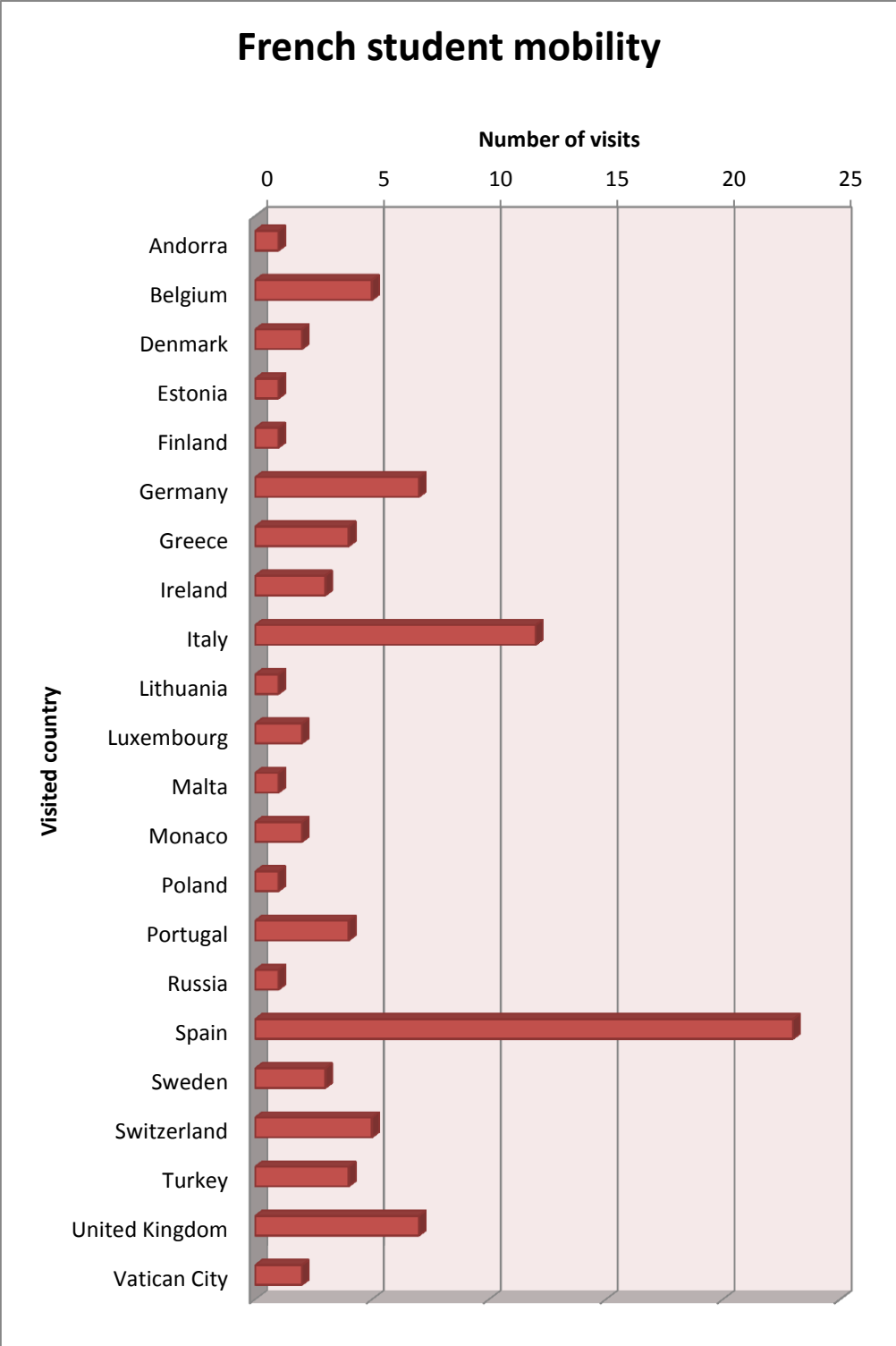
STUDENT MOBILITY SURVEY

February 2013

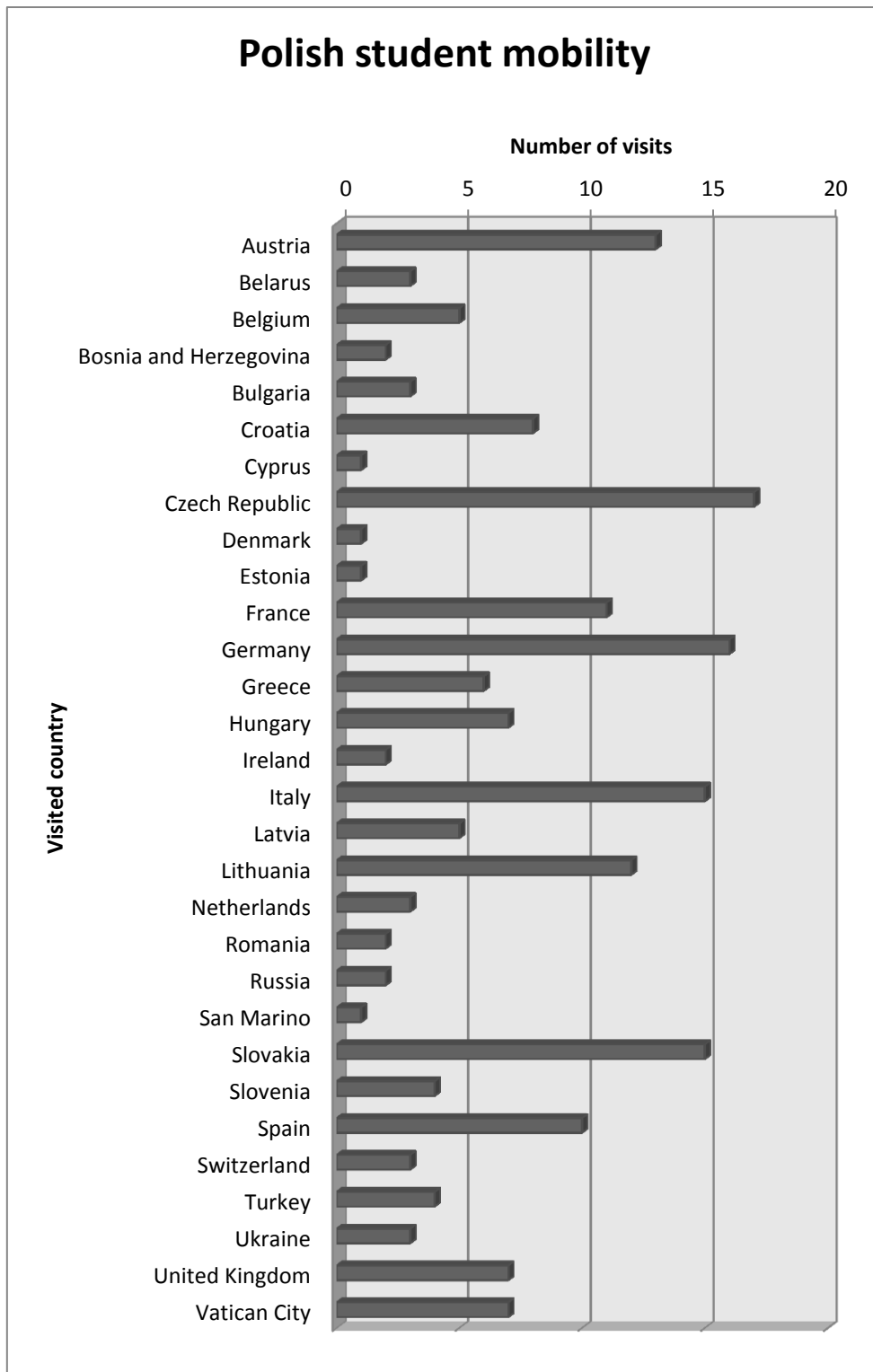
Student mobility survey was done in all of the five project countries during January 2013. Here are the results. The following charts show the number of visits to European countries made by students of all the five project countries.



The number of Finnish students was 25. Most of them had visited the neighboring country Sweden (23) and other commonly visited countries were Estonia (11), Spain (10) and Denmark (9). The Finnish students had visited 26 countries out of 47 European countries.

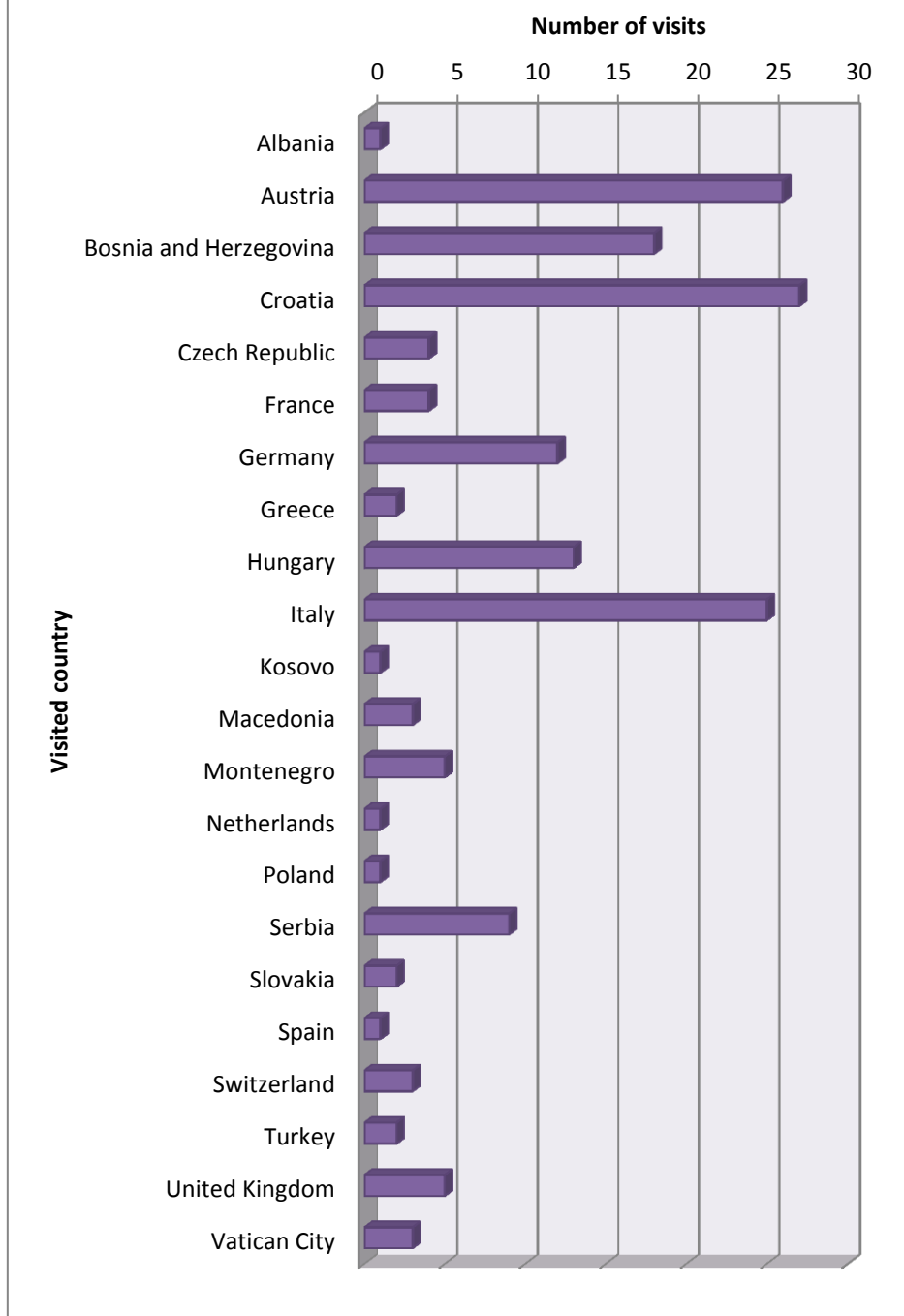


The number of French students was 29. Most of them had visited the neighboring country Spain (23) and the second most visited country was Italy (12). The French students had visited 22 countries out of 47 European countries.

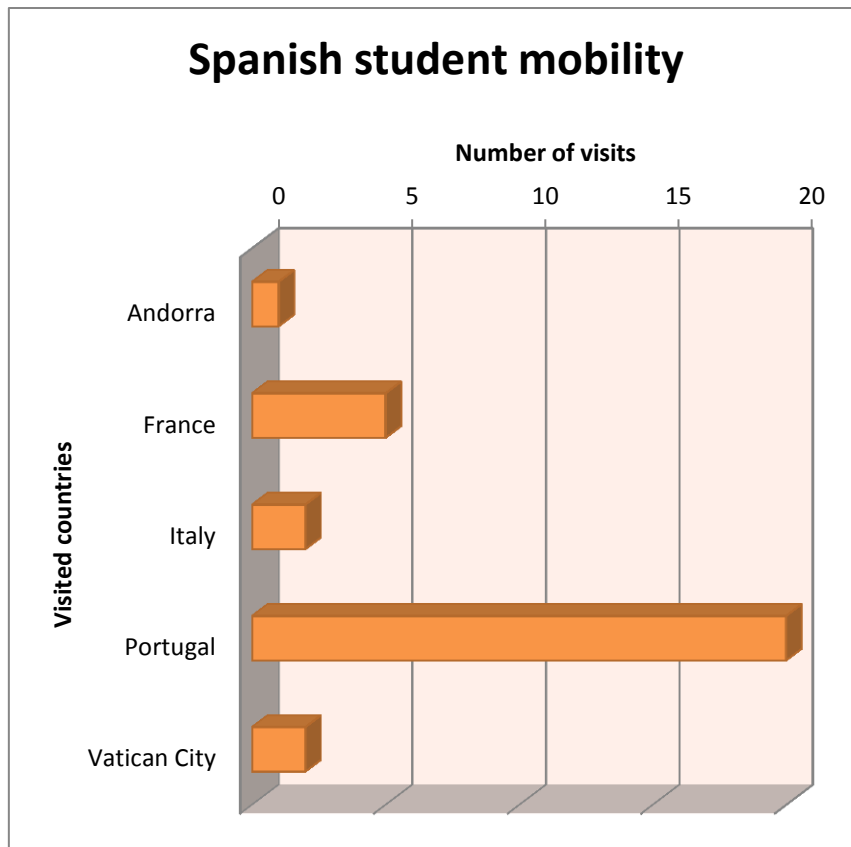


The number of Polish students was 30. Most of them had visited the neighboring countries Czech Republic (17), Germany (16), Slovakia (15) but also Italy (15). The Polish students had visited 30 countries out of 47 European countries.

Slovenian student mobility



The number of Slovenian students was 30. Most of them had visited the neighboring countries Croatia (27), Austria (26) and Italy (25) but also Bosnia and Herzegovina (18). The Slovenian students had visited 22 countries out of 47 European countries.



The number of Spanish students was 30. Most of them had visited the neighboring country Portugal (20) and other visited countries were also situated near Spain. The Spanish students had visited 5 countries out of 47 European countries.

The students from the five project countries had visited altogether 45 out of 47 European countries. Only Moldova and Liechtenstein had remained unvisited. Italy was the most visited country (58 visits) and the next most visited countries were Spain (44 visits), Austria (41 visits), Germany (41 visits) and Croatia (35 visits).
